<b>Application requirements</b>	<p>Students nominated by their home university for exchange studies at UMPRUM are required to submit the filled-out application form signed by their international coordinators along with their:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• curriculum vitae</li> <li>• letter of motivation</li> <li>• electronic portfolio – maximum size 15 MB</li> <li>• copy of the biographical page of passport (only students who have to apply for a visa)</li> <li>• 1 photo</li> </ul> <p>The application and required documents must be sent by email to: <a href="mailto:michaela.bizova@umprum.cz">michaela.bizova@umprum.cz</a></p> <p>Admission is based on the portfolio and artistic quality and the number of spaces available in individual studios.</p>
<b>Studios</b>	All UMPRUM studios are open to exchange students.
<b>Decision response time</b>	About 4 weeks after the application deadline
<b>Language</b>	<p>Applicants are not required to submit results of official language tests but we highly recommend that students have a minimum English language level of B1.</p> <p>International students are integrated among Czech students in the studios and follow the tuition together; parallel or additional tutoring in English or separate consultations in English with international students.</p> <p>The language of instruction of elective courses is English (drawing, bookbinding, clay modelling, Czech language, art history and theory courses, etc.).</p>
